Maintenance fee adjustment this year

The Regency Towers Board of Directors conducted a Reserve Fund Study this year. As a result of the study, the RT board has implemented a 5% regime fee increase for all 120 units in Regency Towers.

Unfortunately, those kinds of increases affect all of us and must be added to our maintenance fees.

However, even with the 5% increase in the maintenance fee, Palmetto Beach Club owners still only pay **58 cents per square foot** for one of the largest home-away-from-home units in Myrtle Beach; giving you a maintenance fee well below the average along the Grand Strand.

Baby Beach Tents Allowed Now

The city of Myrtle Beach has decided to allow 3-foot baby beach tents this year. Regular tents are still forbidden on the beach from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
